Many of us spent the summers together with our families at Sidi Bishr -- isolated in those days. I remember our health school-mate, Neal McClanahan's unexpected death from appendicitis, and all Schutz going to his funeral. I was 9 and sad. During one night of thunder & lightning, some of the older girls came and took the frightened little ones of us to their beds. Martha Roy took me in. Mac Roy used to call me "Dimples", whose own dimples were deep beneath his big, kind blue eyes. Isabel Roy was my "best friend." During eclipses of the moon, I remember mobs of men shouting banging tubles, herding through the "back street." Remember our English matron, Miss Sturgess (and quite tiny), and her nightly bedtime checks and "goodnight" -- her jingling keys. She had an afternoon clinic for skinned knees and sties, and a gathering of us all, before Saturday breakfast, for dose of fizzy Andrews Liver Salts! There were a few "midnight feasts" (bread & halawa etc.) There was the Bible-passages memorizing contest - a sizeable list which Mary McFeeters won and had to recite them all in front of us at morning worship. On my way home in '58 after a short-term at Assiut Hospital while Dr. Kraft and Helen Brownlee were there, I stopped in Edinburgh, Scotland, for a year's work while visiting the land of our forefathers, and met and married my husband. We retired nine years ago into Scottish village life. Here, among the Galloway hills of Covenanter territory, where until only 150 years ago state persecution and slaughter of non-conformists drove them "underground", the Lord is reawaking his remnant, and us new-comers, by the work of His Spirit. Not only the "third world" but even more, perhaps, the western world needs evangelizing. My husband, Bill, has been ill for sometime and can't cope with visitors; but I would love letters from any who want to write, even a short note. 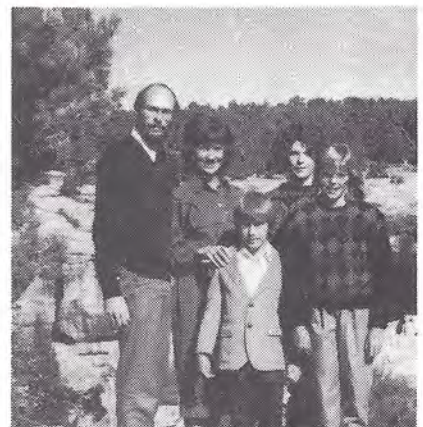
